Safety scissors may be used by the group but penknives / Stanley knives and other sharp objects must not. Over 16's are excluded from this. ▪ Instructor to supervise the preparation of kit.
Misuse of glue and paint	Inhalation or consumption of poisonous substances can lead to severe illness and death.	L	H	5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Only use non-toxic, washable glue and paint. ▪ Fully supervise the use of glue and paint. ▪ Ensure glue or paint does not come into contact with eyes, mouth or cuts. If it does rinse immediately and seek medical advice. ▪ COSHH sheet available if necessary.
Further risks	Any other minor injury from misuse	L	L	9	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ All risks should be minimised by continual appraisal of participants condition, the environment and equipment through dynamic risk assessment by the staff members involved. ▪ Some risks remain but every care must be taken to minimise these.
