Spread of fire to other objects	Burns, asphyxiation.	L	H	5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Fires should be constructed in designated area.</li> <li>▪ Fire to be limited to a controllable size.</li> <li>▪ No toxic materials to be burnt.</li> <li>▪ At least 2 buckets of water should be accessible.</li> <li>▪ A fire extinguisher should also be available.</li> </ul>
Lighting fire	Severe burning.	L	M	6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Firelighting must be supervised by LOPC staff.</li> <li>▪ No lighting fluid should be used under any circumstance (e.g. petrol)</li> </ul>
Tripping	Severe burns, death	L	H	5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Area surrounding fire should be clear of any non essential items and groups warned of potential hazards.</li> </ul>
Fire	Severe burns	L	M	6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Effective group management should be exercised at all times.</li> <li>▪ Ensure all spectators, are at least a 2m distance away from the fire at all times.</li> </ul>
Further risk	Severe Burns	L	M	6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ All risks should be minimised by continual appraisal of participants condition, the environment and equipment through dynamic risk assessment by the staff members involved.</li> <li>▪ Due to the nature of the activity some risk remains but every care must be taken to minimise this.</li> <li>▪ Care must be taken to extinguish the fire and demonstrate clearly that fire embers are not still lit.</li> </ul>
