HAZARD	CONTROL MEASURES
Manual Handling	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Follow recommended procedure to safely move the KataKanu ▪ Where necessary ask for help to move them. ▪ At least 2 people recommended for safe move on and off the trailer ▪ Use the trolley supplied with the KataKanu to easily move the canoe around. ▪ See manual handling risk assessment for further details
Instructor paddling with the group in the KataKanu	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Instructor to make sure they carry a throw line to allow them to rescue from a distance. ▪ Instructor to ensure they are able to easily move around the KataKanu to help people back into the boat. ▪ Instructor to be aware of the lack of manoeuvrability of the craft in case of rescues. ▪ Maximum 6 crew per craft, this includes the instructor.
Use of 2 KataKanus with the instructor on one of them.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Instructor in charge must hold a minimum of Paddlesport Instructor or Level 1 Coaches with internal sign off for Canoeing. ▪ Instructor can paddle a separate canoe to allow them to easily move from boat to boat to perform rescues and coach ▪ If instructor is on one KataKanu they should be aware of their manoeuvrability and their proximity to the other KataKanu in case of rescues. ▪ A throw line must be on board with the Instructor.
